 - Road narrowing at the junction with Mill Road be removed and a raised level installed instead. The same will apply at the narrowing at the north end of village.
 - Double yellow lines to be installed from the Lewis Arms to the first cottage going north.
 - There will not be any build outs at junction with Wyndham Street.
 - There will be no yellow lines from the Spar to the Old Ton.
